
After the pledge and invocation, Mayor Stinson called the Special Meeting to order.



ORDINANCE NO. 2020.09**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FALMOUTH IN PENDLETON COUNTY KENTUCKY AMENDING PRIOR ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT OF ALL REAL ESTATE AND PERSONAL/TANGIBLE PROPERTY, INCLUDING MOTOR VEHICLES, SUBJECT TO TAXATION WITHIN THE CITY OF FALMOUTH FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021, PURSUANT TO THE PENDLETON COUNTY ASSESSOR'S PROPERTY VALUATION ASSESSMENT; AND LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX THEREON FOR CITY PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT AND COLLECTION OF SUCH TAXES AND THE PENALTIES AND INTEREST THEREON; AND DESCRIBING THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE TAXES SO COLLECTED SHALL BE APPROPRIATED AND USED.

PURSUANT TO KRS. 92.280, 132.190.132.487 AND 134.420, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FALMOUTH IN PENDLETON COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

The City of Falmouth hereby provides for the assessment of all real and personal/tangible property, including motor vehicles, subject to taxation within the City of Falmouth for the fiscal year 2020-2021 by use of the annual assessment thereof by the Pendleton County Property Valuation Administrator, Pendleton County, Kentucky.

SECTION II

There is hereby levied on all real property subject to taxation within the City of Falmouth, an ad valorem tax of \$0.665 dollars for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the value thereof assessed pursuant to the terms hereof; and there is hereby levied on all personal/tangible property, other than motor vehicles, subject to taxation within the City of Falmouth, an ad valorem tax of \$0.734 dollars for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the value thereof assessed pursuant to the terms hereof; and there is hereby levied on all motor vehicles subject to taxation within the City of Falmouth, an ad valorem tax of \$0.734 dollars for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the value thereof assessed pursuant to the terms thereof.

SECTION III

The City of Falmouth has a lien on all property upon which ad valorem taxes are hereby levied, and for all penalties, interest, fees, commission, charges and other expenses including court costs and attorneys' fees incurred by reason of any delinquency in payment of such taxes, or in the process of collecting them and such lien has priority over all other obligations or liabilities for which the property is liable.

SECTION IV

The taxes levied and collected pursuant to the terms hereof shall be deposited in the General Fund of the City of Falmouth and appropriated and used for the general operating expenses of the City.

SECTION V

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

SECTION VI

All provisions or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION VII

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording, according to law.
