Keene Dougherty had emailed his report.


Ramona Williams reported she had signed a contract with Adam Scott with Integrated Water Systems to assist in the execution of the KIA Cleaner Water Project funds. He was the liaison with the water districts and familiar with the Grants as he was a former employee with KIA. His fee would be paid out of the CWP money.

Adam Bruener was present as a representative of the Pendleton County Recreation Commission to submit and request that the City install speed bumps at the athletic park behind McDonalds. There is a serious issue with speeding vehicles, and the concern for the safety of children especially when games are being played. Even though there are 10 MPH signs, people are violating the speed excessively. He was aware these had been installed at other locations and it did help reduce the speed. He had given Council a picture of and installation instructions for their review of a like bump he had found. Luke Price asked about cost and who PC Rec expected to pay for this. He was asking the City to pay since it was a City Street. It was stated and reminded that all expenditures were shared by each entity. Council thanked Mr. Bruener for bringing to their attention, and felt it would need to be addressed with attorney before any decision could be made.
