AN ORDER/RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF MARCUS CAREY, ROBERT F. GREENE, DARRYL CUMMINS, CAROLYN TOM **QUIRK** SANDERS. AND ROBERT LAINHART, APPOINTMENT OF WESLEY WILLIAMS AS MEMBERS OF THE **AUTHORITY** REGIONAL **ETHICS** KENTUCKY NORTHERN ENFORCMENT COMMITTEE FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM, COMMENCING FEBRUARY 1, 2017 AND EXPIRING ON JANUARY 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 38.02 (as amended) established a code of ethical conduct applicable to the officers and employees of City of Falmouth and its agencies; and

WHEREAS, at the NKREA's Annual Meeting held December 7, 2016 the Authority Board re-nominated Marcus Carey, Robert F. Greene, Darryl Cummins, Carolyn Lainhart, Robert Sanders, and Tom Quirk to each serve a two-year term on the NKREA Enforcement Committee;

WHEREAS, NKREA Enforcement Committee Member Daniel Cripe resigned and Wesley Williams was appointed by the NKREA Authority Board to fill Daniel Cripe's term; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF FALMOUTH, PENDLETON COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

#### Section 1

That the appointment of Marcus Carey, Robert F. Greene, Darryl Cummins, Robert Sanders, Carolyn Lainhart, Tom Quirk, and Wesley Williams as members of the NKREA Enforcement Committee for a two-year term commencing on February 1, 2017 and expiring on January 31, 2019 is hereby approved.
